Changing Communities One Job at a Time



Many families in Greater Prince William are struggling with the effects of underemployment. These are hard-working people holding down two and sometimes three jobs just to provide the necessities for their families. Underemployment causes:

- financial stress (a key factor in housing instability)
- · negative physical wellbeing
- · psychological and emotional trauma

Rapid Employment (RE) Opportunities can provide an immediate bridge from underemployment to sustainable careers with growth potential. These programs don't just help people find jobs; they transform families, invigorate neighborhoods, and restore dignity and hope.

What Are Rapid Employment Programs? RE programs are workforce initiatives designed to place individuals into career-launching jobs quickly (90 days or less) while offering support services that increase long-term job retention and career success.

Immediate Impact for Families and Communities. RE can break generational poverty, prevent eviction, improve mental health, and reduce crime.

The scope of these supports can include food, housing, utilities, transportation, social connection, personal safety, personal assistance, education, legal assistance, service coordination, and other health-related social needs.
